



How to work out Casement window sash handings.

At Coastal we always view our casement windows from the 'Outside' of the property, so the window drawn below is a 'Left Hand' window as the points of the red arrow point to the 'hinged side'.


Inside the Property

The handle required for this 'Left Hand' window is a 'Right Hand' Handle, as once inside the property the handing switches as shown on the right hand image above.

If you require handed hinges, similar to the 'Defender Restricted Hinges' or the 'Tritus lift off butt hinges' Coastal supply, the hinges you would need for the above 'Left Hand' window would be 'Left Hand' hinges.

How to work out Tilt & Turn window sash handings.

At Coastal we always view our tilt & turn windows from the 'Inside' of the property, this is due to how our suppliers provide us with the hardware, so the window drawn below is a 'Right Hand' tilt & turn master sash window with a turn only slave sash as the points of the red arrow point to the 'hinged side'.
