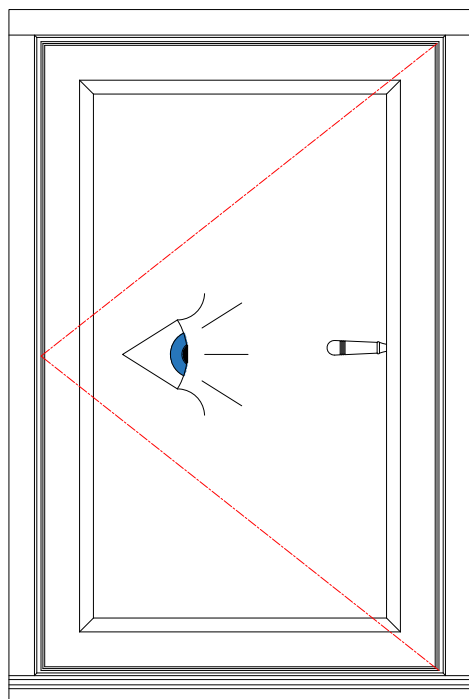


# CASEMENT WINDOW HARDWARE

## HANDING ON A CASEMENT WINDOW SASH

How to work out the handing on a Casement Window Sash

**Hinged Side**

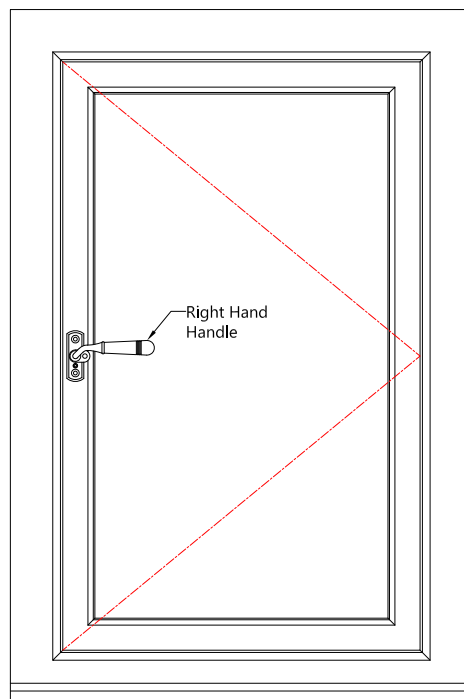


**Lock / Handle Side**

**Outside the Property**

The handle required for this 'Left Hand' window is a 'Right Hand' Handle - once inside the property the handing switches as shown on the right hand image above. It is the hand you would typically use to open the window.

**Lock / Handle Side**



**Hinged Side**

**Inside the Property**

If you require handed hinges, similar to the 'Defender Restricted Hinges' or the 'Tritus Lift Off Butt Hinges', the hinges you would need for the above 'Left Hand' window would be 'Left Hand' hinges.

## Left Hand Hinged Window Shown

We always view our Casement Windows from the 'Outside' of the property, so the window drawn above is a 'Left Hand' window as the points of the red arrow point to the 'hinged side'.
